Whereas, On May 22, 2008, the Pennsylvania State Board of Education amended its bylaws to provide for student membership and greater student voice in education policymaking; and


Whereas, This policy ensures dedicated representation for the more than 1.8 million students enrolled in public schools across the Commonwealth; and
