REPORT OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE BUREAU OF CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION

Dr. Lee Burket, Director of the Bureau of Career and Technical Education (BCTE), highlighted the following items from her written report.

Regional Technical Assistance for School Districts on Compliance, PIMS and NOCTI

In 2017, high schools will begin to seek re-approval of their approved Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs. Chapter 339 requires every approved program to be reapproved once every five years. Technical assistance workshops will be held in Mercer County, Monroeville, Wilkes Barre and Morgantown.

Regional Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) Nontraditional Activities

Bloomsburg University submitted a proposal to BCTE for funding to provide Advanced Manufacturing and STEM Academies during the last full week of school at three sites: Bethlehem Area Vocational Technical School, Benjamin Franklin High School and South Philadelphia High School. Each Academy focused on high-priority occupations that articulate from their CTE to their local community college through the PDE Students Occupationally and Academically Ready (SOAR) Program.

Adult Accreditation

The BCTE is preparing for an accreditation visit to Lebanon County Career and Technology Center on November 14-16, 2016. Dr. Burket said she anticipates presenting a Final Draft Report on the school's accreditation application to the Board in March 2017.
